Behind the Top Workplaces survey

Who determines Top Workplaces? Those who know them best: the employees.

IndyStar partnered with Philadelphia-based WorkplaceDynamics, the employee survey firm, to determine the region's Top

Workplaces rankings. Anyone could nominate a company. The only requirement was that the organization must employ at least 50 people in Central Indiana. The organization could be public, private, nonprofit

or governmental. WorkplaceDynamics invited 1,284 workplaces to participate and surveyed 145 of them. The surveyed firms employ 43,855 people in Central Indiana. Of those employees who received ques-

tionnaires, 22,750 responded. The employee survey seeks responses from 23 statements covering a variety of factors, including management, workforce training, work/life balance, pay and benefits, and a feeling of

appreciation. The survey also measures employee engagement — reten-

tion, motivation and referral. Why is a particular employer not on the list? Perhaps the company took the survey and scored too low. Or, it might have chosen not to participate.

WHO MADE THE LIST?

There were 90 Central Indiana companies identified as Top Workplaces in 2016, five more than the previous year.

The No. 1 large company, Tendercare Home Health Services, has been named a Top Workplace for the fourth consecutive year. The No. 1 midsize company, Royal United Mortgage, has re-

ceived the honor for the eighth year in a row. The No. 1 small company, American Income Life - Indiana, was named to the rankings for the first year.
